 → (about 20-min walk) → Kunozan Toshogu Parking Lot → Hotel Grand Hills Shizuoka
- Please be aware that there will be a significant stair climb during this part of the tour although the view of Suruga Bay and the Pacific Ocean from the Ichi-no-mon Gate, which is located at the top of 909 steps, is spectacular.

Kunozan Toshogu Shrine

This is the founding shrine of all "Toshogu" shrines in Japan and is the only national treasure building in Shizuoka Prefecture. This is a shrine dedicated to Tokugawa Ieyasu (whose main shrines include Toyotomi Hideyoshi and Oda Nobunaga), and the attached museum exhibits the famous swords Sohayano Tsuruki and Kinda. The museum has a large collection of beautiful items, Western clocks, items used by Prince Ieyasu, and extremely valuable treasures of successive Shoguns. (From official X account)
